In accordance with Federal regulations, Atlantic City has prepared a Draft 2020-2024 Five Year Consolidated Plan, 2020 Annual Action Plan and an update to the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing for Community Development Programs. This document is a requirement for direct assistance under U. S. Dept. of HUD funding programs including the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and the Home Investment Partnerships Program (HOME),

The 2020 Action Plan, which includes the proposed use of funds, is available during the period of 4/1/20 to 4/30/20 for citizens, public agencies and other interested parties to examine its contents and to submit comments. Citizens may submit their comments on the Action Plan through the mail, email, or by telephone Monday through Friday from, 9 to 4. Comments will be received until 5/1/20.
